How do I access the Item Shop?

a. Using your browser

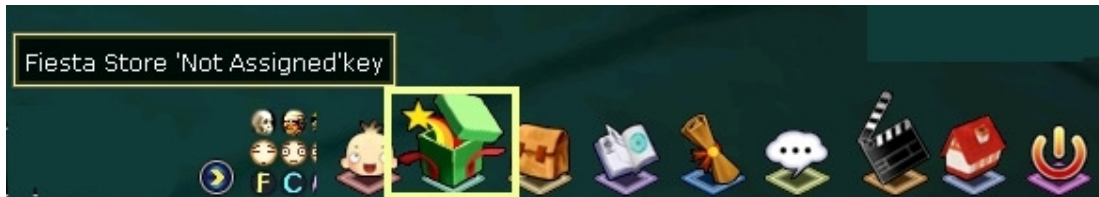
Visit the Item Shop via the official website: <https://itemshop.en.fiesta-online.de/>

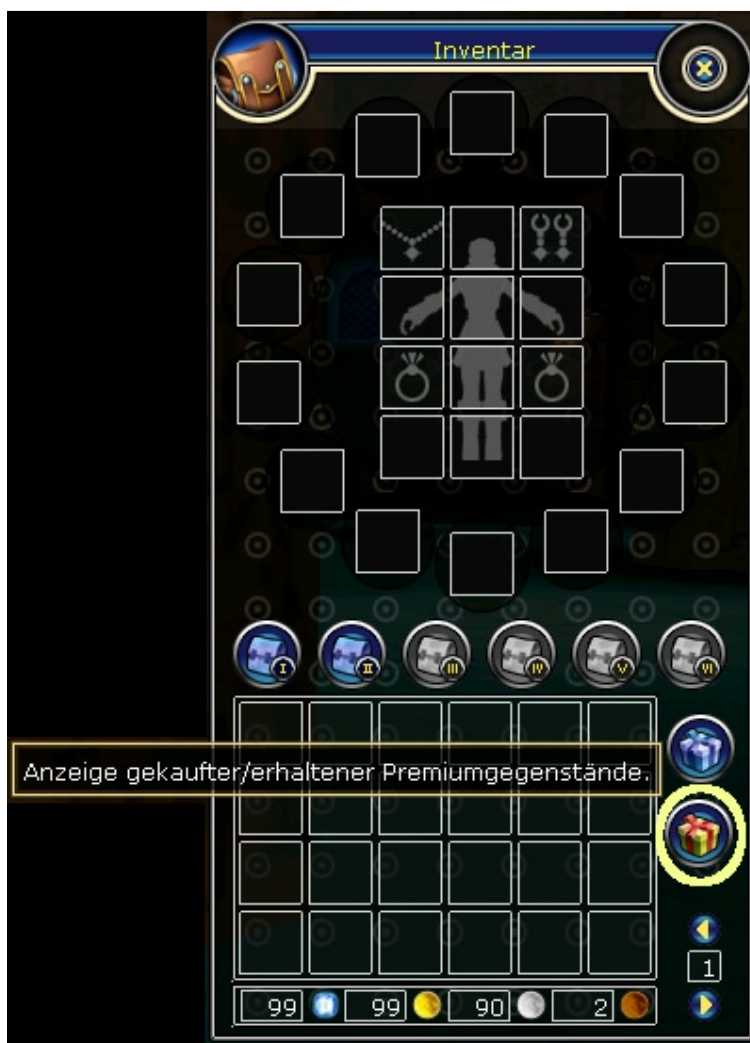

If the list contains items that you do not want, you can remove them from your order by clicking on the button with a green mark. This will only remove the item in question and not the entire order.



Once you have purchased items, they are added to your account. To add these items to a specific character on your account, open the inventory while you are in game and click on the gift package icon in your inventory (marked in red). Right click on the item you wish to bestow upon your character.



Once the item is in your inventory, you generally right-click on it to use it. Some items need not be activated (eg beauty coins, item enhancement stones).
